

Dear Quick Terrain Modeler Trial User,

Thank you for your interest in Applied Imagery's Quick Terrain Modeler software. The process of obtaining a temporary key is outlined below. Please note that it is a multi-step process, but will require minimal time commitment on your part. To understand the process, we have provided a checklist and step-by-step instructions below.

Step 1: Choose Appropriate Quick Terrain Modeler Version:

There are four Quick Terrain Modeler versions available on Applied Imagery's Quick Terrain Modeler Trial web page (<http://www.appliedimagery.com/qtmtrial.php>). Please note that due to export restrictions, users in the United States should download the USA version and users outside the United States should use the International version.

- **USA 32-Bit:** The 32-bit version requires a 32-bit or 64-bit Windows operating system.
- **USA 64-Bit (X64):** The 64-bit version requires a 64-bit Windows operating system.
- **International 32-Bit:** The 32-bit version requires a 32-bit or 64-bit Windows operating system.
- **International 64-Bit (X64):** The 64-bit version requires a 64-bit Windows operating system.

Finally, please note that Applied Imagery will never sell or market your contact information to any third party for any reason.

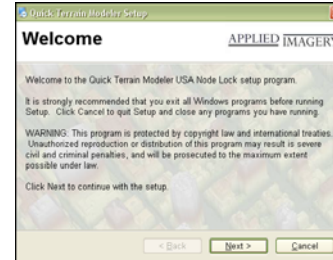
Step 3: Download Quick Terrain Modeler (1 minute):



The download page will provide a link for both the Quick Terrain Modeler software and the User's Manual. The User's Manual is not necessary to run the software, but may prove helpful during the trial.

Step 4: Install Quick Terrain Modeler (2 minutes):

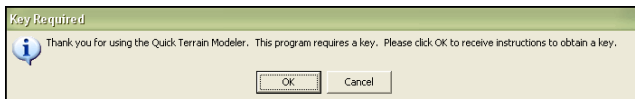
Once the download is complete, install Quick Terrain Modeler on your PC.



Step 5: Run Quick Terrain Modeler (1 minute):



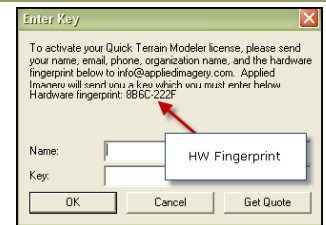
Once installed, run Quick Terrain Modeler for the first time. It will request a key, which is not included in the download.



Please click "OK" on the first message screen and proceed to the "Enter Key" screen. Please note the "Hardware Fingerprint".

Step 6: Send Quick Terrain Modeler Hardware Fingerprint (30 seconds):

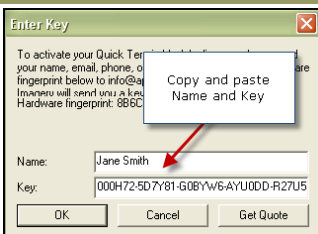
Please send the Hardware Fingerprint to info@appliedimagery.com. The hardware fingerprint is unique to your PC and is required to create your key.



Step 7: Receive Email from Applied Imagery:

Applied Imagery will send you an email with a temporary key as soon as possible, but this is not an automated process and may require verification of your email address.

Step 8: Input Temporary Key:



Please copy and paste both the Name and Key exactly as sent to you by Applied Imagery into the appropriate fields in the "Enter Key" screen.

Please note your trial period begins when a key is issued by Applied Imagery, not when the key is entered.

Step 9: Proceed with Trial:
